

Roadworks are starting in your area soon

What's happening, where and when?

What: Cutting back Highway vegetation, lining refresh, pothole repair and gully cleaning.

Where: A6003 between Corby Bypass & Oakley Road roundabouts

When: Monday 14 November to Friday 25 November (not weekends)

How long: 10 working days

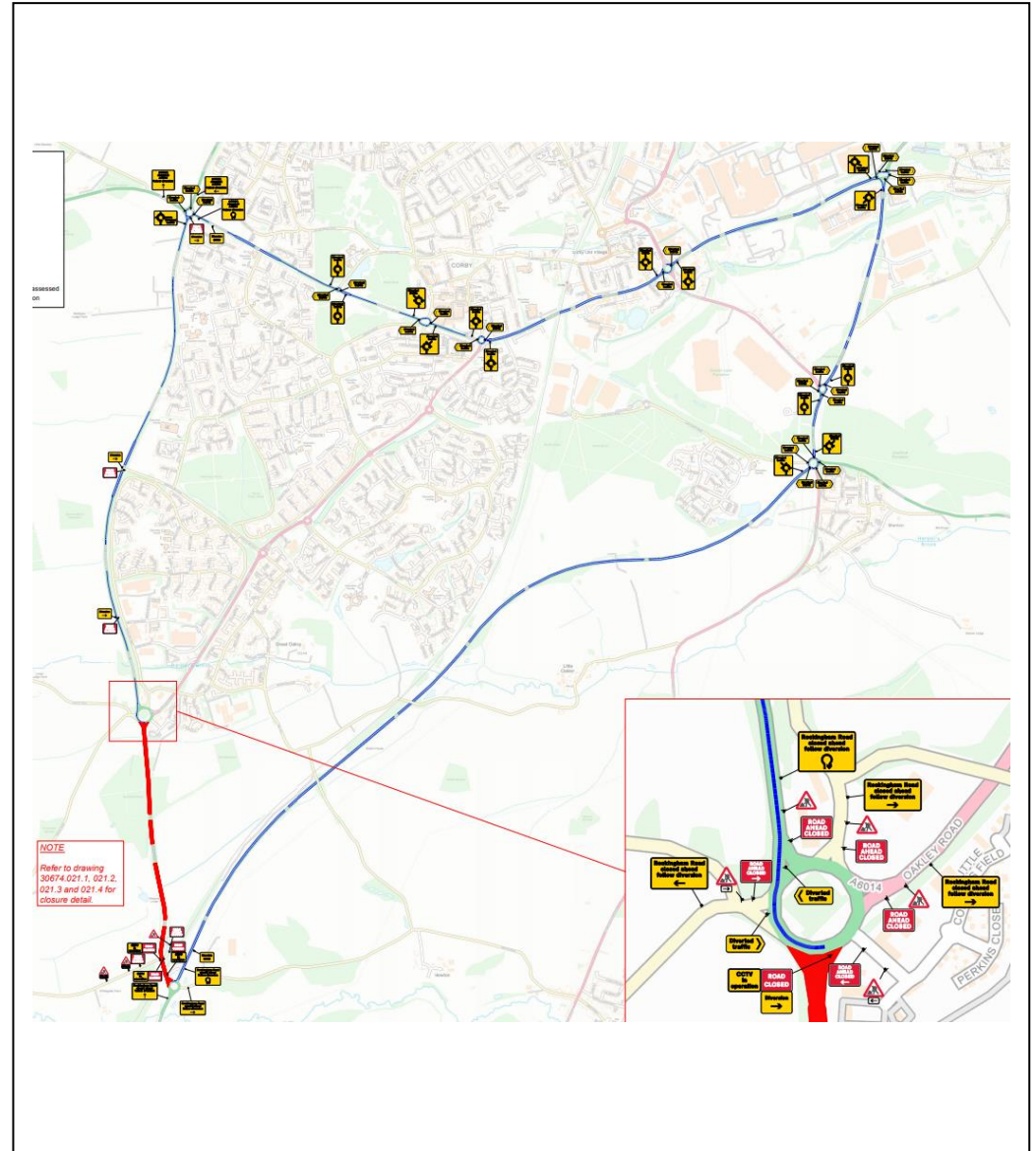
Traffic Management: Road closure in both directions. A diversion will be in place at all times as shown on the map below. The **red** line shows the road closure extents, and the **blue** line shows the diversion route.

Hours: 09:30 to 15:30

Emergency Vehicles: We will endeavour to safely escort emergency services through the closure.

Residents: Residents will be allowed access either from Corby Bypass roundabout or Newton Road, Rushton.

Public Transport: Have been notified & will automatically detour.





Parking and Property/Business Access
